CAMO Trail Rating System:



With a ton of new members popping up with diverse rigs, needs, and expectations, I wanted to design a route rating system that is easy to understand so that you can attend an event without encountering surprises, let downs, or any combination of the two.

T.R.S

Level 1:

- Driving Surface
 - A combination of Paved Roadways, Highway, Dirt Roads, and unimproved roadways
- Drivetrain Restrictions
 - \circ ~ None: 2wd Friendly in dry conditions
- Roadway Width:
 - Full Size Truck Friendly. Travel trailer capable if driver will not be traveling excessively slowly and is skilled/experienced.
- Clearance Restrictions:
 - AWD Crossover (Forrester/Crosstrek) capable. Possibility of scraping on unimproved roadways
- Fuel
 - Spare fuel likely not needed, but suggested
- Protection and Armor:
 - None Required *Unless low clearance (Crossovers)*
- Tires:
 - o Any treaded tire

Level 2:

- Driving Surface
 - o Dirt Roads, Unimproved Roadways, Country Single Lanes, 2 Track Wide Trails
- Drivetrain Restrictions
 - 4wd Suggested, 2wd acceptable for experienced drivers with recovery gear and aggressive tires
- Roadway Width:
 - Tight for Full Sized Trucks, Pinstriping likely
- Clearance Restrictions:
 - Medium Clearance Stock Height Trucks and SUVs
- Fuel:
 - Suggest Spare Fuel
- Protection and Armor:
 - None Required, Suggest Oil Pan Skid
- Tires:
 - o Any All Terrain

Level 3:



- Driving Surface
 - o Unimproved Roads, 2 track trails, overgrown sections, sporadic obstacles
- Drivetrain Restrictions
 - o 4wd Required
- Roadway Width
 - o Too tight to navigate courteously with a full-sized truck. Pinstriping Guaranteed
- Clearance Restrictions:
 - Medium Clearance Stock Height Trucks and SUVs
- Fuel:
 - Suggest Spare Fuel
- Protection and Armor:
 - o Strongly Suggest Oil Pan/Radiator Skid Plate. Begin Considering rock sliders
- Tires:
 - All Terrain Tires 31"+

Level 4:

- Driving Surface
 - 2 Track Trails, overgrown sections, obstacles requiring a spotter, Rocks exceeding 12", Muddy sections
- Drivetrain Restrictions:
 - o 4wd Required
- Roadway Width
 - o Narrow, some areas requiring a spotter, pinstriping guaranteed, possible trail damages
- Clearance Restrictions:
 - Medium Clearance to High Clearance Stock Trucks may start to struggle
- Fuel:
 - Strongly Suggest Spare Fuel
- Protection and Armor:
 - o Oil Pan/Engine Skid required (STRONGLY SUGGESTED) Suggest Rock Sliders
- Tires:
 - o 31 inch tires will struggle, Aggressive All Terrain Suggested



- Level 5:
 - Driving Surface:
 - Overgrown or unexplored trail sections, obstacles requiring a spotter. Rocks or logs exceeding 24". Deep water or mud.
 - Drivetrain Restrictions:
 - o 4wd Required, Rear Locker Suggested but not required
 - Roadway Width:
 - No established width, minor damage possible, pinstriping guaranteed
 - Clearance Restrictions:
 - Mid-Sized Trucks and SUVs with 2" non-spacer lift (anomalies would be jeeps and similar short wheelbase trail vehicles)
 - Fuel:
 - Spare Fuel Strongly Suggested
 - Protection/Armor
 - o Suggest Steel/Aluminum Bumpers, Full Underbody skids, Rock Sliders
 - Tires:
 - o **33**″ +
